Civil Legal Aid for Persons with Disabilities Who are Victims of Crime

The Disability Law Center may be able to provide **FREE** legal assistance to Persons with Disabilities who are crime survivors with civil matters related to the person's disability.

As part of the Civil Legal Aid to Victims of Crime Initiative ("CLAVC"), DLC may provide **FREE** legal assistance in the following areas:

- **Housing**
- **Employment**
- **Education**
- **Healthcare**
- **Disability Rights**

To be eligible for this **FREE** legal assistance from DLC, the person with a disability must:

- 1) **Be a victim or a survivor of a crime*;**
- 2) **Have a civil (non-criminal) legal problem that is a result of the crime; and**
- 3) **Must live in Massachusetts, or the legal problem must be in Massachusetts**

* The crime does not need to have been reported to the police or prosecuted.
